

On Sunday, June 29, 2008, a congregational meeting was held to address a motion from the congregation to the Board of Directors directing them to develop a detailed phase 1 design consistent with the master plan concept approved in December, 2007. The meeting consisted of a presentation of findings, a recommendation from the Board of Directors, a motion to accept those recommendations and an open discussion of all the members present.

Upon concluding the discussion, the following motion was approved:

- **Recommend approval of current design plan for phase 1A and 1B and request ongoing value engineering before finalizing.**
- **Immediately begin construction on Site Work Infrastructure in preparation for new construction and to make immediate positive impact on GSLC's existing ministries (using cash on hand).**
- **Continue accepting contributions for GSLC Building Fund. (No professional campaign planned at this time.)**
- **Set goal of a \$9mm building fund. Begin building construction of phase 1A when contributions/pledges of \$5mm received AND weekly worship attendance reaches an average of 700 across 3 services.**

For those who were not able to attend, phase 1A and 1B refers to the new worship center and activity center design that has been presented over the past 6 weeks to various ministry groups, church leaders, small group leaders and the congregation as a whole in between Sunday services. Site work refers to the necessary parking, drives, drainage, utilities etc. that would be needed for any eventual new construction but can be utilized now for our existing facilities as well.

It would be impossible to capture all of the valuable discussion and comments made during the meeting but I want to thank each of you, on behalf of the congregation, for that input as we take the next step forward with our campus redevelopment as we strive to provide more ministry opportunities.
