“I assure you before God that what I am writing you is no lie” (v20)

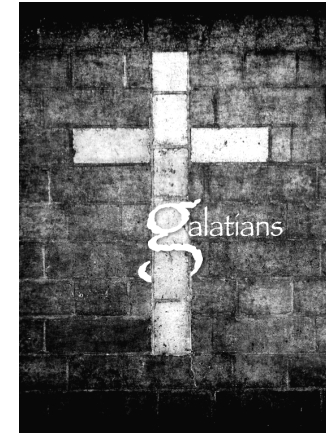
